ABOUT PORTLAND

<u>Portland, Oregon</u>, is a vibrant and scenic city in the USA's Pacific Northwest. The largest city in the state, it's famed for its huge expanses of green space, from parks and forests to breathtaking

mountaintops. Portland has many nicknames: Rose City, Beervana, Portlandia, and Bridgetown, to name a few.

People are drawn to <u>Portland</u> for the beautiful outdoors located close to the urban center. The <u>downtown</u> area where IRMACON2023 is being held is cool and quirky, with great places to <u>shop</u> and even better places to <u>eat and drink</u>. There's fine dining and street food, as well as countless <u>breweries</u>, <u>distilleries</u> and <u>coffee shops</u> to experience, too.

<u>Portland</u> is a port city and the largest city in the U.S. state of <u>Oregon</u>. Situated at the confluence of the <u>Willamette</u> and <u>Columbia</u> Rivers, <u>Portland</u> is the county seat of <u>Multnomah County</u>, the most populous county in <u>Oregon</u>. As of 2020, <u>Portland</u> had a population of 652,503, making it the 26th-most populated city in the United States, the sixth-most populous on the West Coast, and the second-most populous in the Pacific Northwest, after Seattle. Approximately 2.5 million people live in the <u>Portland</u> metropolitan statistical area, making it the 25th most populous in the United States. About half of <u>Oregon's</u> population resides within the <u>Portland</u> metropolitan area.

THE HOST HOTEL

The Embassy Suites by Hilton Portland Downtown is a member of the Historic Hotels of America and is on the National Register of Historic Places. The Embassy Suites was originally built as the Multnomah Hotel and opened with 700 rooms in 1912. For many years it was the most famous and prominent hotel on the Pacific Coast. Prominent guests include, Charles Lindbergh, Rudolph Valentino, Amelia Earhart, Jimmy Stewart, Bing Crosby, Jack Benny, Elvis Presley, and every president from Theodore Roosevelt to Richard Nixon.

The <u>Multnomah</u> closed in 1963. From 1965 to 1992 the building housed government offices. After the building shutdown in 1992 it sat dormant until 1995 when it was sold, remodeled and opened in

1997 as the 276-suite <u>Embassy Suites Hotel Downtown Portland</u>. Much of the historic style of days gone by is evident in this beautiful property today.

The luxurious all-suite hotel combines historic style with modern convenience and technology, delivers a memorable stay for IRMA Members. The location in <u>Old Town Portland</u> assures easy and convenient travel access to the <u>PDX Airport</u>, nine miles away, as well as all of the most interesting sites in <u>Portland</u>. Their suites deliver all of the comfort and modern amenities you need. Large 65 inch televisions, Wi-Fi access, in-suite coffee, and in-suite safe.

All suites are furnished with a microwave and mini refrigerator. Each morning from 6.00am – 9.00am, IRMA Members may enjoy a complimentary cooked to order American Breakfast. Each evening from 5.30pm – 7.00pm the hotel offers a complimentary reception with wine, beer, cocktails, and soft drinks.

Guest Rooms: Embassy Suites Single or Double-Bedded Guest Rooms – \$205.00 single or double occupancy. Rates – are in US Dollars and are plus occupancy tax, currently 16%.

In addition to the regular menu, the cuisine of a different mother each month is celebrated and a menu, lovingly referred to as the "Mother of the Month" (or "M.O.M.") menu is offered.

Arrival/Departure: The Embassy Suites check-in time is 4:00pm PT on your scheduled day of arrival with a checkout time of 11:00am PT on your scheduled day of departure. Guests arriving before 4:00pm PT will be accommodated in their reserved suite type on a first available basis. The bell staff will arrange to check baggage for guests arriving early when suites are not available. The Hotel facilities are available for use by IRMA guests in either of these circumstances.

- 1. <u>Light Rail</u> the <u>MAX light rail Red Line</u> is the easiest way to travel to and from the airport. Here are some quick facts:
 - a) The trip between Portland Airport and downtown takes about 38 minutes.
 - b) The light rail station with the closest access to the <u>Embassy Suites</u> is <u>SW 1st and SW Oak Street</u> @ three (3) blocks from the hotels. You could either <u>walk</u> (<u>see interactive map</u>) or take a Ride Share from there
 - c) An adult ticket costs \$2.50 (Youth / Honored Citizen \$1.25). Get the latest ticket and pricing information on the <u>TriMet</u> website.
 - d) You can roll your luggage on board.
 - e) The first train of the day arrives at PDX at 4:45 a.m. The last train departs PDX at 11:50 p.m.
 - f) The <u>MAX</u> station and ticket machines are located on the lower level, next to the south baggage claim area (turn right at the base of the escalator). <u>View airport map</u>.
 - g) For complete schedules and more information, visit the <u>Red Line page</u> on the <u>TriMet</u> website.
- 2. Via <u>Shared Ride Services</u>. The current shared ride cost begins at \$24.00 for the 9-mile drive to the <u>Embassy Suites</u> from <u>Portland International (PDX)</u>.

- 1. Take I-205 S from NE Airport Way; 6 min (2.7 mi)
- 2. Continue on I-205 S
- 3. Take I-84 W/US-30 W to SE Morrison Bridge
- 4. Exit from I-84 W/US-30 W; 10 min (8.7 mi)
- 5. Continue on SE Morrison Bridge. Drive to SW Pine St; 3 min (0.5 mi)
